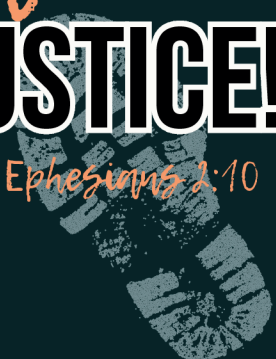

Youth will participate in a Christ-centered process that equips families, mentors, and organizations to surround each student with trusted, intentional adults—helping them discover their identity, gifts, and vision through guided reflection, goal-setting, and a full year of support.

Students will engage in a variety of activities alongside their community organization designed to strengthen their sense of identity, uncover their unique gifts, and shape a clear vision for their future.

On May 16, encircle and BJMJ will host a “Mentorship Gathering,” launching this year-long journey and guiding students toward feeling closer to God, more connected to others, and better prepared for what’s next.

SERVICE PROJECTS

Students will participate in two impactful service projects designed to build leadership, empathy, and a strong sense of community. These experiences encourage students to step outside the classroom and become the change they want to see.

Through a back-to-school Block Party and “Feeding Our Unhoused Neighbors,” students will develop teamwork, communication skills, and compassion while connecting with others in meaningful ways.

Together, these projects help students grow as leaders, deepen their sense of purpose, and understand the power of giving back.



THE LEGACY EXCURSION

Students will embark on a multi-day immersive trip to The King Center, Legacy Museum, and Edmund Pettus Bridge, exploring the intersection of faith and justice through the lens of identity, gifts, and vision. In these historic spaces, students will reflect on who they are, what they carry, and how their unique strengths can shape the world around them.

Through engagement with primary sources, meaningful dialogue, and shared reflection, students will deepen their understanding of faith as lived out through justice—drawing connections to the teachings of Jesus and the call to love, serve, and act with courage. This overnight experience fosters self-awareness, strengthens their sense of purpose, and helps students begin to envision how their faith can guide them in making a lasting impact.
